NEW SERMON SERIES: "NAMES OF GOD"

There is often a direct correlation between the names that God gives Himself and the names He gives His people. Abram could not become Abraham until Abram first understood God to be "God Almighty" (see Gen. 17). Moses could not carry out his task of prophetic shepherding until he had first received God's name "I AM" (see Exodus 3). This reminds true for us today. God is still naming His children, but in order for us to live confidently in the names that God gives us we must first allow God to name Himself.
